

Fool's Regatta Saturday, 8/16 @ East Ferry

Cruise Report

A total of 13 boats participated in all or parts of the 2014 Summer Cruise between July 26th and August 3rd. Destinations included Block Island, Shelter Island, Essex and Stonington. Eleven boats were owned by members of JYC. Boats started to assemble in Block Island from the Wednesday before July 26th, by which time 9 boats had arrived in New Harbor. A big surprise were the Doherty's on Patriot who had sailed overnight from New York and arrived at around 6:00 in the morning. On Sunday boats started to head to Coecles Harbor on Shelter Island, and by Tuesday most boats had reunited at the Shelter Island Yacht Club in Deering.

In Deering a mini Fool's Rules race was held. Each boat had been given a small starter kit from which to build a small sail boat, which could used other non boat items that could be found. The basic rule was that the constructed boat must fit within a two foot cube. In the end 12 entries were built and the race was set up along the bulkhead in front of the yacht club. At first the wind looked to be more or less parallel to the shore which was good for the intended course, but at the start the wind switched to more off shore and boats scattered in several directions. Bruce Underhill had built the most impressive, best engineered boat which took off for Greenport at great speed and had to be retrieved, along with others that were directionally challenged or partially sank. However, it then became apparent that a few boats were actually sailing the intended course parallel to the shore and eventually Vic

Calabretta was declared the winner. After this epic race a group dinner was held in the yacht club.



On Thursday most boats left for Essex on the Connecticut River, to moorings at Essex Yacht Club. The remainder of Thursday and Friday were spent in Essex or some took advantage of the steam rail / boat trip up the river. On Friday evening a group dinner was held at the yacht club. The club was very welcoming and has undergone some recent renovations and hired a new chef, who produced an impressive menu.

On Saturday most of the remaining boats left for Stonington. This was the most unpleasant day of the cruise with winds from the East, with heavy rain, so everyone motored all the way to Stonington. After drying off everyone assembled at the Dog Watch Café for dinner. Sunday morning everyone was up early to take advantage of the tide out of Fisher's Island Sound for the sail home to Jamestown.
